This project included the reconstruction of 12 miles of four-lane pavement along I-40 mainline west of Oklahoma City, as well as the design of a six-lane facility. Also included in the design was the replacement and widening of eight bridges located within the project limits. The project was designed to enable four lanes of traffic to operate throughout construction. The work included three (3) separate construction packages. Engineering work was completed in two (2) months under an accelerated schedule in an effort to have the projects "shovel ready" for the 2009 Stimulus Funding under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). Total cost of the three packages was estimated at approximately \$110 million, and was among the largest of the list of projects prepared by the Oklahoma Department of Transportation for stimulus funding.
