Poe & Associates was selected by the Oklahoma Department of Transportation and the City of Edmond to complete the I-35 Corridor Study from the John Kilpatrick Turnpike north to Waterloo Road.

During the first project update meeting with ODOT and the City of Edmond, it was recommended by the consulting team to separate out the frontage road study from E. Memorial Road to E. 2nd Street from the rest of the corridor. In addition to the existing frontage roads south of E. 2nd Street, the overall study will consider additional concepts north of E. 2nd Street. The overall study and the area of study relevant to this frontage road report are shown on the maps on the previous page. The study will also identify safety and capacity needs for the I-35 mainline and consider improvements to interchange ramps. The study will result in concept designs of the selected improvements.
