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Poe & Associates was selected by the City of Wichita to design the Redbud Pedestrian Path between K-96 and 159th Street East. The chosen design is a 9' concrete path with a 1' foot gravel shoulder and 4' gravel shoulder. Also included in this project is the design of an 8" waterline and 21" sanitary sewer line from 127th Street East to Founders Circle. The waterline will connect to mains on Founders Circle and Garnett Street. The sanitary sewer will connect to a 15" and 18" line at Founders Circle. The existing pump station will be demolished. As part of this project, Poe was also tasked with evaluating the eight existing bridge structures along the project and providing a recommendation on their viability to be converted into pedestrian/bike bridge facilities. The City is currently evaluating the recommendations and deciding on the best way to proceed with the bridges.

When complete, the Redbud Bike Path will not only provide a "linear park" for citizens to enjoy while improving recreation and quality of life, but it will also provide an alternate path for other modes of transportation, enhancing connectivity within Wichita.
