Description: The Wichita office of Poe & Associates is currently part of the design team for the new Kansas Star Casino in Mulvane, Kansas. Peninsula Gaming received the license to develop the state-owned casino at Exit 33 along the Kansas Turnpike, seven miles south of Wichita. Poe is designing the underground utilities to serve the \$260M casino. Peninsula plans to open an interim casino in February 2012 inside a building that will eventually become an events/convention/equestrian center. The interim casino will include 1,310 slots, 32 gaming tables, a 50 seat snack bar, and several food and beverage kiosks, the company has said.

The permanent casino is scheduled to open in January 2013. It will include more slots and tables, a 10 table poker room, a buffet, steakhouse, food court, two bars, and a 150 room hotel. Upon final completion in 2015, the Kansas Star Casino will have 2,000 slots, 50 tables, a 300 room hotel, an RV park, a gift shop, and an expanded equestrian events/entertainment/convention center.
