The Chisholm Creek Sanitary Sewer Relief Line project from N.W. 150<sup>th</sup> to N.W. 115<sup>th</sup> Street included the construction of approximately 7,300 feet of 36-inch and 3,900 feet of 30-inch sanitary sewer relief line, generally extending from NW 150<sup>th</sup> Street, west of Western Avenue to NW 115<sup>th</sup> Street, east of Pennsylvania Avenue. Also included in the project was the preparation and submittal of an Environmental Information Document (EID), Corps 404 permits, and Oklahoma Turnpike Authority permits. Services included survey, design, specifications, bidding documents, and as-built drawings.
